

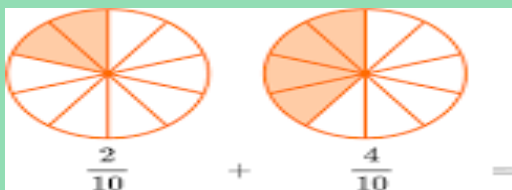
As Readers and Authors we will be:

As Geographers and Historians we will be:

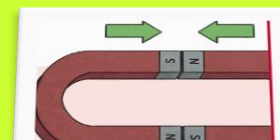
- Looking at Europe.
