

In Literacy we will:

- being to learn and recognise digraphs sh, ch, th, ng, ee, ai, igh, oa, oo, or, ar.
- start to use our digraphs in our writing.
- begin to write extended sentences focusing on using a capital letter and a full stop.
- use finger spaces independently.
- focus on lead in strokes and exit strokes on our letters.
- answer questions about what we have read.



In Maths we will:

- look at coins and compare their properties such as what they look like and what numbers are on the coins.
- double numbers to 5
- halve even numbers to 10.
- start counting in 2s, 5s and 10s and group objects into these amounts.
- count forwards and backwards to and from 20 confidently.
- look at properties of 2D and 3D shapes such as sides, faces and using language such as curved, flat, straight.
- learn that teen numbers are 10 + another number.
- add and subtract 2 single digit numbers.

As members of our community we will:

- learn how to care about baby animals with our chicks.
