#### As readers and authors we will:

- Write a fictional narrative based on the "Tiddler" stories.
- Use books, leaflets and the internet to find information about sea animals and creatures.
- Create fact files about sea animals using the information that we have found.



#### As mathematicians we will:

- Continue to learn the 2X, 3X, 5X and 10X tables.
- Understand how to divide and solve problems with division and multiplication.
- Solve money problems involving addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.



#### As Linguists we will:

- Continue to learn how to use capital letters, full stops, exclamation and question marks.
- Learn how to spell words with the "ly" suffix. For example, slowly, happily.



#### As Geographers we will:

- Use atlases, maps and the internet to find where the different oceans and continents are and label them on world maps.
- Understand what pollution is and the effects on the oceans. We will look at recycling and how we can make a difference to the environment.

#### As athletes we will:

- Improve our basic skills to improve our fitness, co-ordination and balancing abilities.
- Take part in weekly tennis lessons at Queens Tennis club. (Every Tuesday afternoon.)



#### As scientists we will:

- Learn about ocean habitats and what different animals need to survive.
