


Summer 1 Learning in Year 3: Ancient Egypt

As readers and authors we will:

focus our reading and writing around the book 'Egyptian Cinderella'. From this, children will write some alternative fairy tales and non-chronological reports linked to Ancient Egypt. We will be encouraging children to think about paragraphing in their writing and using subheadings. Children will also be expected to be using in their writing a range of openers, conjunctions and punctuation that has been taught in year 3 so far.



As athletes we will:

practise different ways to move and balance focusing on our core strength. We will also be continuing to practice our throwing and catching skills to incorporate these in the games we play.



As scientists we will:

continue to learn about plants. We will then extend our knowledge looking at the functions of parts of plants and the conditions they need to grow. We will carry out different experiments that will help us to learn about the function of the plants. We will also try to grow some different plants in class.



As mathematicians we will:

continue to look at written methods for addition and subtraction and will introduce a formal written method for multiplication. Finally we will be introducing the formal written method for division. We will continue to practice our 3, 4 and 8 times tables.



As members of our community we will:


have a trip to a local museum looking at how Ancient Egypt impacted the local area.

As Geographers and Historians we will:

be looking at where Ancient Egypt is in the world and researching the River Nile. We will compare and contrast our lives and living conditions to what is what like then. We will also be re-enacting some of the famous discoveries from Ancient Egypt.

As linguists we will:

continue to develop our fluency in the language covered so far. We will learn some new phrases to help us ask questions and provide answers about ourselves in French.



As artists and designers we will:

be using different sketching pencils to create some detailed drawings. We will also be using clay and etching in the Eye of Horus to make small bowls. We will also be creating some fantastic hieroglyphic paintings.

As musicians we will:

be learning how to perform together looking at how music is written, how lyrics are formed and how to put all these together to produce a group performance.
