The Arctic

As readers and authors we will:

be reading a variety of texts including those linked to our topic. We will be writing our own setting descriptions and poetry around winter. We will look at a variety of grammar features including those linked to our writing genre.



As mathematicians we will:

be looking at the perimeter of simple shapes, converting between measures and short multiplication. We will also continue to practise our written methods of calculation and mental strategies. We will also be focussing on our times tables.



As linguists we will:

be continuing to build on new vocabulary we learn and how to use new phrases in different situations.



As historians and geographers we will:

be looking at the key physical features of the Arctic region. We will also look at the Arctic circle and its location in the world. We will learn about people who live in the Arctic and how they survive whilst comparing them to how we live.

As members of our community we will:

be looking at living in the wider world.



As athletes we will:

be lucky enough to have a sports coach to teach us the fundamental skills of gymnastics. Furthermore, we go swimming to Halifax baths every week to learn / develop our swimming skills.
