- completing and solve reasoning challenges within number.

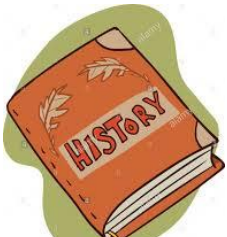


As linguists we will be:
