Our Buildings

We are a two form entry primary school, split across two sites; each building accommodating Reception to Year 6.

Heath Site

Our Heath site is located in the beautiful grade 2 listed former grammar school building on Free School Lane. It has a number of exciting learning environments including a large library area, a wildlife garden and a versatile studio.

Moorfield Site

Our Moorfield site is a purpose built facility opened in 2004, which provides a fantastic facility for learning. It benefits from a large computing/ library area, community room and from 2020 a new sensory/ breakout space.

Both of our sites provide opportunities to enhance and stimulate a love of learning outside the classroom environment. These are regularly used by classes, collaborating together, from both our sites.

Our Curriculum

At Savile Park School we pride ourselves on the fact that our pupils are inspired and supported to reach their full potential. Exciting topics are designed to make learning fun and personalised to meet the needs of our pupils. Learning experiences are enhanced through educational visits and visitors and specialist teachers.

Sports & Extra Curricular Clubs & Activities

PE has an important place in the school day and the importance of exercise for a healthy lifestyle is one of the main aims of physical education at our school. A variety of after school clubs are provided by school staff and external providers.

We operate successful Breakfast Clubs at both of our sites. These provide a positive start to the school day through a healthy breakfast and a range of activities, incorporating learning and social development.
