As readers and authors we will be:

Continuing to develop our comprehension skills by explaining what effect an author's choice of vocabulary has on the reader. In our writing we will be creating brochures to persuade people to visit Trinidad, using rhetorical questions, modal verbs and imperative verbs.



As mathematicians we will be:

- Using co-ordinates and translation
- Using decimals
- Learning about negative numbers
- Converting units of measure
- Learning about volume

As linguists we will be:

Describing appearance such as eye and hair colour.

<u>As computing specialists we will:</u> Be using computers to create 3D shapes.







<u>As athletes we will be:</u> Developing skills in athletics and developing footwork.

Studying animal and human life cycles. This will include the changes that happen to our bodies as we grow up. You will receive another letter about this next term.
