As readers and authors we will:

- be reading a variety of texts including those linked to our topic. We will be writing our own fictional stories and news articles surrounding our class text
- look at a variety of grammar features including those linked to our writing genre.



As mathematicians we will:

- be consolidating our knowledge of number bonds to 100 and identifying what each digit within a number represents including Roman Numerals.
- continue to practise our written methods of calculation and mental strategies. We will also be focussing on our times tables.





As historians and geographers we will:

- be looking at the key events that shaped modern day crime and punishment including the Romans, Saxons and Victorians. We will explore a number of historical items and use these to answer historical lines of enquiry to create a picture of events in time.
