As Readers and authors we will be:

- Practising to write in full sentences with full stops, capital letters and finger spaces
- Listening to stories; Superworm, Supertato and Zog.
- Writing some descriptions linked to our class stories
- Using role-play to explore, sequence and retell our favourite stories.
- Sequencing events in simple stories.

As mathematicians we will be:

- Reading and writing numbers to 10 and beyond, comparing and ordering numbers and identifying 1 more and 1 less
- Counting forwards and backwards to 10.
- · Recognising numbers in words.
- Adding and subtracting using objects.
- Beginning to recall and use number bonds to 10.
- Using number lines.
- Comparing numbers using the vocabulary Less than, greater than and equal to.

As members of the community we will be:

- Learning about which beliefs are important to us and other people in our local area.
- Learning about Harvest Festival and why it is important.
- Learning about new beginnings and relationships and how we can express feelings and emotions
- Exploring our local area and discuss how we can improve it.
