What's happening in Key Stage 1

Year 1

Year 1 will be learning to use technology safely and respectfully, keeping personal information private, identify where to go for help and support when they have concerns about content or contact on the internet or other online technologies

Year 2

Year 2 will be researching websites linking to the concept of being 'safe' online. Using excellent resources on www.thinkyounknow.cm. They will use the context of imaginary characters set in imaginary worlds to help them understand the risks associated with sharing personal information online and how to make informed choices.

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Lower Key Stage 2

Year 3 will be looking to understand that risks can be reduced by using appropriate behaviours. Also that there are risks in using communication technologies. They will be producing posters to show others how to stay safe. This will then link to discussions on storing information and images in a safe place.

Year 4 will be aware of the SMART thinking messages that will help them stay safe. The children will be navigating the Think U Know's Cybercafe. Year 4 will be developing our online communication and blogging skills.

Upper Key Stage 2



Year 5 children will be learning to understand that cyber-crime can take a number of forms. To understand chat room and instant messaging. How to behave appropriately towards others online. To understand the consequences of online bullying. To also realise that information on the internet can be biased or inaccurate.

Year 6

To know some strategies for safe use of mobile devices. To know the significance of having a good online reputation. To understand the potential consequences of having a negative online reputation and misuse of social networking sites.
