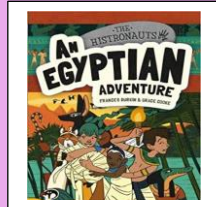


As readers and authors we will be:

As athletes we will be:

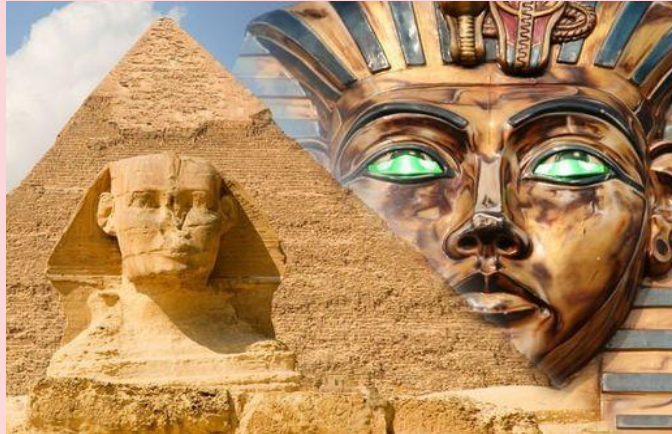
- Practising different ways to move and balance focusing on our core strength.
