As Readers and Authors we will be:

- Reading a variety of texts including those linked to our topic of The Romans.
- Looking at debates and comic book style stories
- using inverted commas to portray speech within our stories.
- Continuing to work on our text structure and organisation including writing paragraphs around a theme.
- Showing understanding of features of different genres.
- Working on our grammar by using conjunctions to express time (before, after, as, when, since).

As Mathematicians we will be:

- Looking multiplication and division in a formal written method.
- Learning about length and perimeter.
- We will also be looking at fractions.

As Linguists we will be:

- Continuing to increase our French vocabulary and
- Learning how to use new phrases in different situations.





As Historians and Geographers we will be:

- Learning about where the Roman Empire began.
- Developing research skills to find out about Julius Caesar and what Roman Soldiers wore and why.
- Looking at the Roman invasion of Britain

Looking at living in the wider world and how people can inspire us.


As Artists and Designers we will be:

- Choosing and joining a variety of materials to make sculptures.




As Athletes we will be:
