Bikeability



We are delighted to be able to inform you that Bikeability courses are restarting this term and Year 5 will be taking courses this term.

Bikeability is the Department for Transport's national award provider for cycle training in England.

It is a progressive programme where riders will first master cycle handling skills in a motor-traffic-free environment (Level 1), then develop their skills and confidence to cycle on single-lane roads and simple junctions with mostly moderate motor traffic flows (Level 2), before tackling busier/or faster roads, and complex junctions (Level 3). After completing the training, Bikeability cyclists receive a booklet, a badge and a certificate to recognise training completed.
