



FRENCH AT SAVILE PARK PRIMARY

At Savile Park we are extremely proud of our modern foreign languages curriculum, we teach French in KS2 (year 3 - 6), our curriculum is designed support pupils to build on existing knowledge and skills. Year 3 can often be the first time a child will learn a foreign language and in this year group they will use speech and limit written tasks to learn the basics.

Our aim is to enable children to be confident in speaking other languages. We give children the opportunity to speak in French.

As they move up from Year 3 children will see much more of the written language and build on their early skills, allowing pupils to hold a conversation (asking a question and replying confidently), write and listen to stories and answer questions, with much more skill.

We cover a range of topics and themes in Key Stage 2.

Children will learn:

- Key phrase and words in French.
- Be able to understand and respond in French.
- Able to respond to simple instructions.
- To have a simple conversation in French.

At home

There are so many ways we can include French learning at home.

Learn alongside the children: find out what they are learning and ask them to teach you some key words and phrases. They might like to make a simple poster illustrating key words and phrases, or use sticky notes to label everyday objects in French. Another good idea is to create a 'new words' dictionary for them to record all the new things that they have been learning.
