We were so excited to see so many Year 6 and their parents at the end of term leavers event last night.

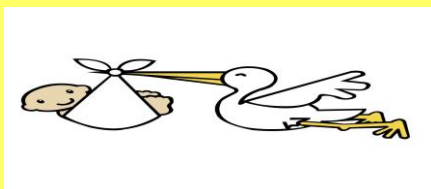
