Early Birds Breakfast Club

Breakfast club is run out of the Heath site and we transport the Moorfield children to their classroom ready for the start of the school day.

Breakfast club runs from 7.45am until the start of school at a cost of £4.00 a session with breakfast included and £2.00 for pupil premium pupils.

We offer a wide range of activities including football, go noodle, homework help, reading support, Lego, arts and crafts.

Breakfast is the most important meal of the day. We try to ensure our children's needs are met first thing in the morning, by providing the following options: toast with various toppings, cereals, croissants, waffles, pancakes, juices, water.

Children are asked what they would like to eat and where possible, we try to accommodate. We open at 7.45 and serve for a full half an hour before clearing down for activities. Hope to see you all there.

The children will complete field work activities such as identifying the geographical features of a river, as well as measuring the depth and flow rate.

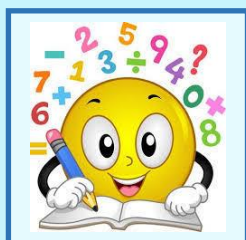
Year 3 Stone Age Woman

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Savile Park House Point System
