In PSED we will:

- Develop the friendships we have created.
- Express their feelings and become aware of the feelings of others.
- Continue to make new friends think about how to be a good friend.
- Talk about making healthy choices with regards to food, drink and exercise.



In Understanding the World we will:

- Learn about religious celebrations which are happening.
- Learn about Remembrance Day and why it is important.
- Learn about Bonfire Night, when it happened and what people do on Bonfire Night.
- Look at the changes between seasons from Autumn to Winter.
- Learn why it is important to look after our natural world.
- Explore the links between seasons and growing.



In Physical Development we will:

- Continue to practise holding a pencil using a tripod grip.
- Practise patterns and begin to form letters.
- Practise dressing and undressing by ourselves.
- Learn how to safely use PE equipment.



In Communication and Language we will:

- Listen carefully to others, taking our turn to speak and listen.
- Engage in story times, listening carefully and begin to retell the story.
- Begin to learn and use new vocabulary.
- Begin to ask questions based on our learning.

In Expressive Arts and Design we will:

- Sing familiar songs and nursery rhymes.
- Learn new songs linked to our Topics.
- Learn to sing and perform as part of a group.
- Investigate different instruments and how they are used.
- Learn about rhythm and a beat.
- Use different materials to create pictures
- Learn how to access the areas independently and how to change our equipment
- Create different pieces of art work linked to our topics using a range of media.



In Maths we will:

- Practise reciting numbers to 20.
- Recognise numerals to 20.
- Order numerals to 5.
- Subitise the number of objects to 5.
- Learn to find the correct number of objects.
- Compare numbers and groups of objects to 5.
- Recognise and begin to talk about 2D and 3D shapes.
- Match the spoken number to the written number.
- Begin to find 1 more and 1 less.
- Explore the composition of numbers to 5.
- Begin to explore number bonds to 5.
