As Mathematicians we will be:

focusing on consolidating and extending the children's learning to enable them to solve problems involving all aspects of the numeracy curriculum in our preparation for the forthcoming SATs.



As Readers and authors we will be:

exploring the classic Scottish play - Macbeth by the famous play-writer William Shakespeare. We will be accessing the text through drama and role play and will be developing narrative skills with a focus on developing settings and characters.



As linguists we will:

learn to give well-structured descriptions and explanations and develop our understanding through speculating, hypothesising and exploring ideas.

As Historians we will be:

- continuing to develop historical knowledge of the Vikings from the 1st Viking raids through to Edward the confessor
