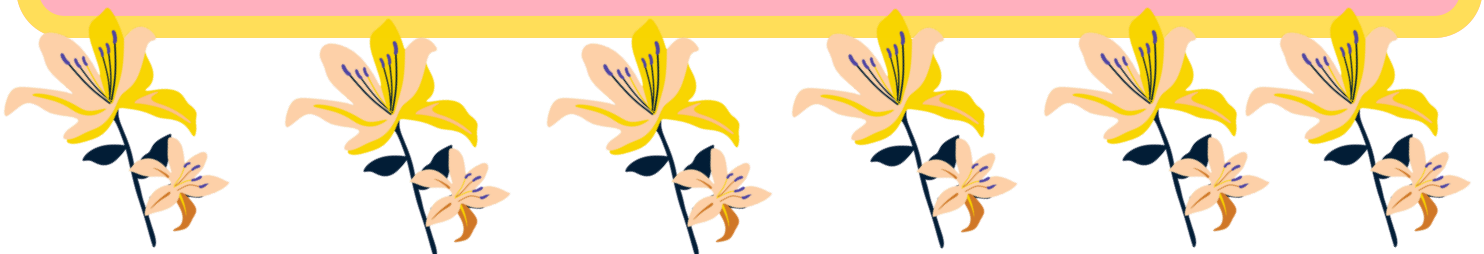


And finally...
