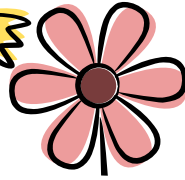
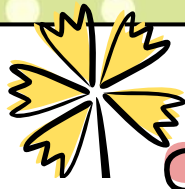
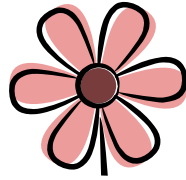
We would appreciate your co-operation in being mindful and parking safely and not parking on corners or the grass verge, would be much appreciated.

Year 6 Poetry Slam Competition



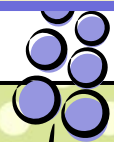
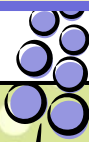

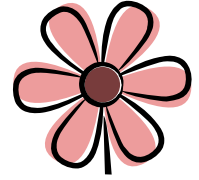
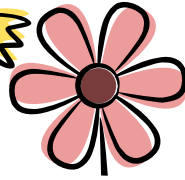
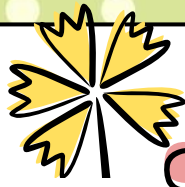
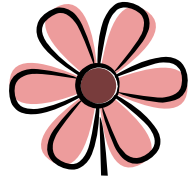
Tick-Tock, It's School O'Clock!

Thanks a million for your awesome support in setting them up for a day full of learning adventures!

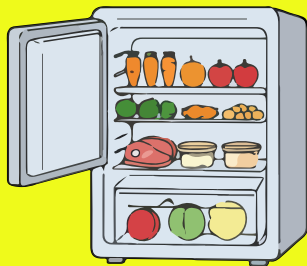




Community Fridge

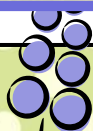

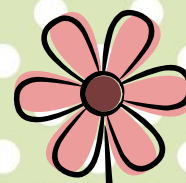


Diamonds playing in Manor Heath Park
