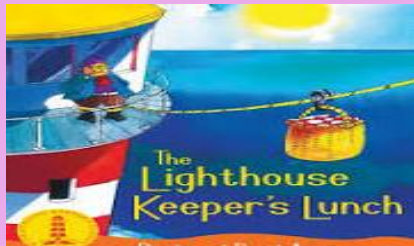


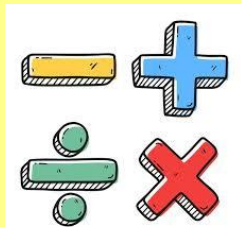
As readers and authors we will:

- Look at stories with the same author.



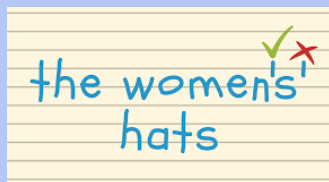
As mathematicians we will:
